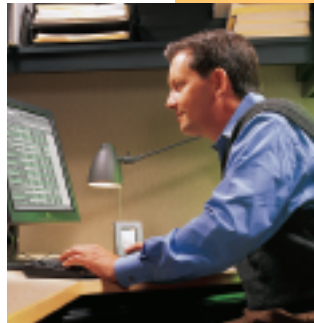

UK-based T-Mobile serves 80 million customers worldwide. The company wanted to provide 2,000 customer service operators in four contact centers with access to its key billing application, while eliminating the need for on-site IT support. Also, field engineers doing maintenance on network base stations required remote access to applications to eliminate paper records.

T-Mobile implemented Citrix Presentation Server running on Microsoft Windows 2000 Server to provide centrally managed access to its billing application, saving £12 million the first year. The company also provides remote application access to engineers via wireless laptops. Benefits include better customer service, as operators now have continuous access to all applications needed to address an inquiry, and improved efficiency in field maintenance.

Secure, Scalable Access for Mobile Professionals

The South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services (SCDPPPS) supervises offenders and helps them succeed in their communities within the framework of public safety. Its professionals, who travel to courtrooms around the state, needed secure access to the network to retrieve case-related information. But its IPSec VPN presented firewall traversal issues and heavy support demands, limiting scalability.



SCDPPPS implemented the Citrix Access Gateway, which offered a competitive price, plug-and-play implementation, and a downloadable client that eliminates manual upgrades. The remote control feature allows desktop sharing for remote troubleshooting. With Access Gateway, the organization can easily support its users and expand its IT capabilities.

In the 1990s, organizations began to see the benefits of providing their employees and partners with remote access to information resources across the Internet. To achieve Internet-based access while maintaining corporate security, they turned to IPSec VPNs. However, it has become apparent that using IPSec VPNs for remote access creates security concerns, limits accessibility, impairs usability and increases maintenance costs. Attempting to address these issues, vendors created the SSL VPN. While this solution was less expensive than IPSec VPNs, it introduced a new set of access limitations and was still somewhat difficult to maintain. A better solution was needed.

Citrix Access Gateway is a universal SSL VPN appliance that combines the best features of IPSec and typical SSL VPNs — without the costly and cumbersome implementation and management — to make access easy for users, secure for the company, and low-cost for the IT department. The Access Gateway provides a secure, always-on, single point of access to any information resource. It works through any firewall; supports all applications and protocols, including IP telephony; is fast, simple and cost-effective to deploy and maintain via its Web-deployed, auto-updating client; and ensures that devices meet company security standards with a worm-blocking client and integrated end-point scanning. The Access Gateway automatically and seamlessly reconnects users to their applications when they change locations and devices, and gives them the same access experience they have at the desktop.

Citrix Access Gateway provides secure access to any application hosted on Citrix Presentation Server, as well as distributed Windows and UNIX applications, direct-access Web applications, network file shares, data and collaboration services, and even telephony services using VoIP softphones. With the addition of the Advanced Access Control Option, the IT organization can utilize sense and respond capabilities to not only provide or deny access to appropriate applications, but also control the level of user action rights for each application or resource accessed.

Password Manager helps protect corporate information assets by enabling IT to set policies that enforce strong passwords. This means that users only need to remember a single, strong password. And with Password Manager's support for leading multifactor authentication solutions, IT can further strengthen access control.

Citrix Password Manager can be configured to change application passwords automatically at desired intervals to ensure a higher degree of protection.

Self-service password reset allows users to reset their domain password from their PC instead of calling the help desk, further reducing administration costs.

Sharing of workstations is common in banks, hospitals, manufacturers and retailers. The Hot Desktop functionality of Password Manager enables users who share workstations to logon/logoff in seconds instead of using a time-consuming, full Windows or Novell logon/logoff procedure.
